

**Eat Logic** are a new future jazz project who combine electronic and acoustic elements with UK street idioms, jazz flavoured textures and improvisation. Their players and singers have helped to define the sound of British electronic music over the past two decades – members of some of the UK's most groundbreaking bands join forces with vocalists who hold a firm place in the history of British acid jazz and electronic dance music.

The band's 'RIYL' list includes some long-time friends, colleagues and strangers alike - The Bays, Cinematic Orchestra, de Phazz, Portico Quartet, Labrinth, Weather Report, Ennio Morricone, David Arnold, Zero 7, Massive Attack, Bugge Wesseltoft, Fenomenon, The Latin Project, D\*Note, The Sunburst Band and Incognito.

"We've always been excited by the unique sounds created by some of the people we've worked with" (Labyrinth, Massive Attack, Basement Jaxx, Imogen Heap, amongst others), says Gordon Hulbert, the band's founder and musical director. "Hopefully that carries through into what we're doing, but we're also concerned with good composition and how we lock together as musicians. As sidemen we've laid it down behind artists like Chaka Khan, Roy Ayers, Don Blackmon, Hugh Masekela etc, so we also hope to bring that tradition and quality of musicianship into our live performances."

The debut EP, also called '**Eat Logic**', will be released on 18th May. A launch party will be announced to tie in with the release.

**Eat Logic** are currently talking to festivals and venues and hope to announce some dates soon.
